1. Pray as a family or with some friends for our missionaries on Missions Sunday, December 6.
2. Visit a Nursing Home to visit with the elderly.
3. Volunteer in the Stone Creek food pantry.
4. Have a neighbor over for dinner.
5. Send a Christmas card/note explaining what Christmas really means to you.
6. Take a friend or co-worker out for coffee.
7. Pray over a school in your neighborhood.
8. Thank a police officer for his/her service to the community.
9. Bring Christmas cookies to a neighbor.
10. Pray for another church in your neighborhood.
11. Give blood or plasma.
12. Help a neighbor with a cleaning project.
13. **Weekly invite someone to our Christmas Series "Miracle on Race Street."**
14. Donate furniture to a local ministry.
15. Have a conversation with and buy a meal for a homeless person.
16. Rake a neighbor's yard.
17. Visit someone in the hospital.
18. Randomly offer to pray for a friend or co-worker.
19. Babysit for a single mom to give her some quiet time.
20. Collect your loose change around the house and donate it to a local ministry.
21. Fast for a day. When you get hungry, think of those who go multiple days in hunger.
22. Write a letter to a soldier and send a care package to one of the military personnel in the weekly program.
23. Go through your closet donate clothes you haven't worn recently.
24. Volunteer your time to help a single parent family with some chores around the house.
25. Write a letter/Christmas card to a missionary on our missions list and encourage them.
26. Give an encouraging note to your employer or teacher.
27. Host an international student for a holiday meal.
28. Thank a firefighter for his/her service to the community.
29. Volunteer at a local homeless shelter or soup kitchen.
30. Write an encouraging note to a mentor and or spiritual leader who has impacted your life.
31. Bring some snacks for your co-workers or classmates.
32. Participate in McJoyful Miracles by giving money to bless some children in the Ukraine with a meal.
33. Go on a prayer walk through your neighborhood and pray for the different families/homes.
34. Reconnect with someone with whom you have a strained relationship.
35. Shovel a neighbor's driveway/sidewalk.
36. Check on shut-ins, particularly during severe weather.
37. Go Christmas Caroling in your neighborhood and ask for prayer requests.
38. Collect canned goods in your neighborhood to bless a struggling family or a local ministry.
