1. Paul reveals his _____.

“This letter is from Paul, an apostle. I was not appointed by any group or by human authority. My call is from Jesus Christ himself and from God the Father, who raised Jesus from the dead.” **Galatians 1:1.NLT**

“For I want you to know, brothers and sisters, that the gospel that was proclaimed by me is not of human origin; for I did not receive it from a human source, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ.” **Galatians 1:11-12.NRSV**

“And the leaders of the church who were there had nothing to add to what I was preaching ...They saw that God had given me the responsibility of preaching the Good.” **Galatians 2:6-9.NLT**

“I was one of the most religious Jews of my own age, and I tried as hard as possible to follow all the old traditions of my religion.” **Galatians 1:14.NLT**

“In Christ we are set free by the blood of his death, and so we have forgiveness of sins. How rich is God’s grace, which he has given to us so fully and freely.” **Ephesians 1:7-8.NCV**

“For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith— and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no-one can boast.” **Ephesians 2:8-9.NIV**

“I am not one of those who treats the grace of God as meaningless. For if we could be saved by keeping the law, then there was no need for Christ to die.” **Galatians 2:21.NLT**
“God is the one who began this good work in you.” **Philippians 1:6.CEV**

“The LORD will fulfill his purpose for me.” **Psalms 138:8**

“For if you are trying to make yourselves right with God by keeping the law, you have been cut off from Christ! You have fallen away from God’s grace.” **Galatians 5:4.NLT**

“Is it not clear to you that to go back to that old rule-keeping, peer-pleasing religion would be an abandonment of everything personal and free in my relationship with God? I refuse to do that, to repudiate God's grace. If a living relationship with God could come by rule-keeping, then Christ died unnecessarily.” **Galatians 2:21. MGS**

“Therefore, I do not treat God's gracious gift as something of minor importance and defeat its very purpose; I do not set aside and invalidate and frustrate and nullify the grace of God. For if justification (righteousness, acquittal from guilt) comes through [observing the ritual of] the Law, then Christ (the Messiah) died groundlessly and to no purpose and in vain. [His death was then wholly superfluous.]” **Galatians 2:21. Amp**

“As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.” **Galatians 1:9.NKJV**

“For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, *and* not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect.” **Hebrews 10:1. NKJV**

“It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.” **Galatians 5:1.NIV**
