- The church is a community where the fruits of the Spirit are on display (Galatians 5:22-23).

- The church is a place where the gifts of the Spirit are in operation (1) Corinthians 12, 14).
- The church is a place where the currents of God are flowing (5-fold ministry giftings, Ephesians 4:11-13).
- Which of the 5-fold ministry giftings do you see developing in your life? Or which are you curious about? Have a natural bent towards?
- The church is a place where people are equipped and led by the Holy Spirit (Book of Acts).
- In what ways do I need to be better equipped in my walk with Christ?
- The church is a place where people actively seek the Baptism of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2).
