The Three Movements of Seeking Prayer

Matthew 7:7-8: Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.

Asking —> Seeking

Self-centered —>God-centered

Psalms 63:1: You, God, are my God, earnestly I seek you; I thirst for you, my whole being longs for you, in a dry and parched land where there is no water.

Hebrews 11:6: But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Petition -> Devotion

Earnestly- aggressively pursue Diligently- hardworking and focused

Devotion has:

A priority- Acts 3:1: Now Peter and John went up together to the temple at the hour of prayer, the ninth hour.

A place- Mark 1:35: Now in the morning, having risen a long while before daylight, He went out and departed to a solitary place; and there He prayed.

A pattern- Matthew 6:9: This, then, is how you should pray...
